

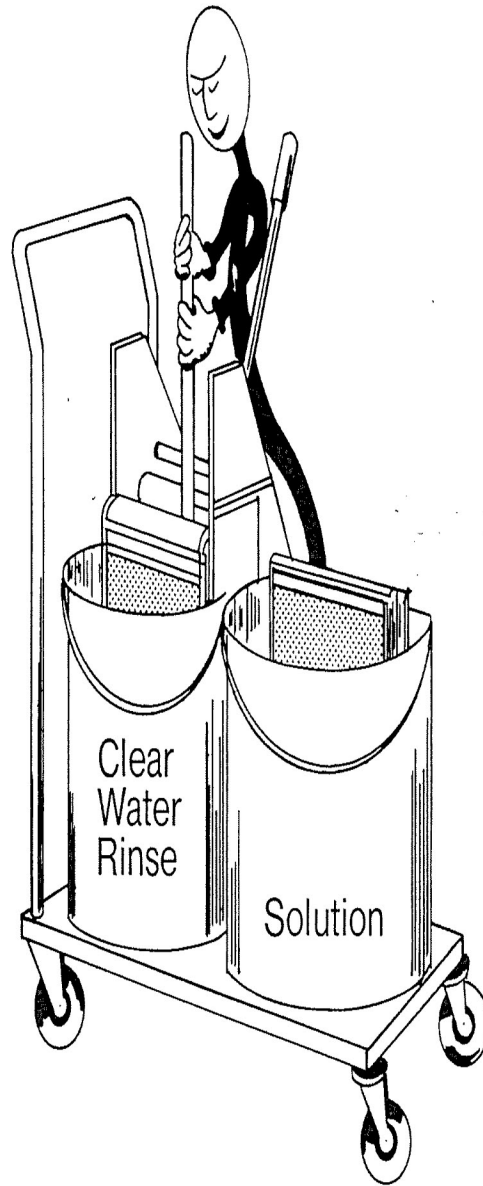
MOPPING PROCEDURE

Place mop wringer on clear rinse water tank—DRIP PAN on the cleaning solution tank. Then follow instructions below:

1. Fill both buckets with at least two gallons of water. This is always the minimum amount. Maximum will depend on area to be covered and instructions from supervisor. Amount of cleaner in solution pail will also depend on area to be covered and instructions from supervisor.
2. Immerse wet mop in solution, take wet mop from solution and place mop in drip pan for a few seconds to remove excess water as dictated by the operation. Apply solution to floor.
3. Return mop to clear water rinse bucket. Agitate the mop to remove dirt picked up in the operation. Wring out mop.
4. Return to area where solution was laid and pick up solution. When returning, put mop in clear water rinse, agitate, and wring out mop.
5. Repeat above until area assigned is finished.

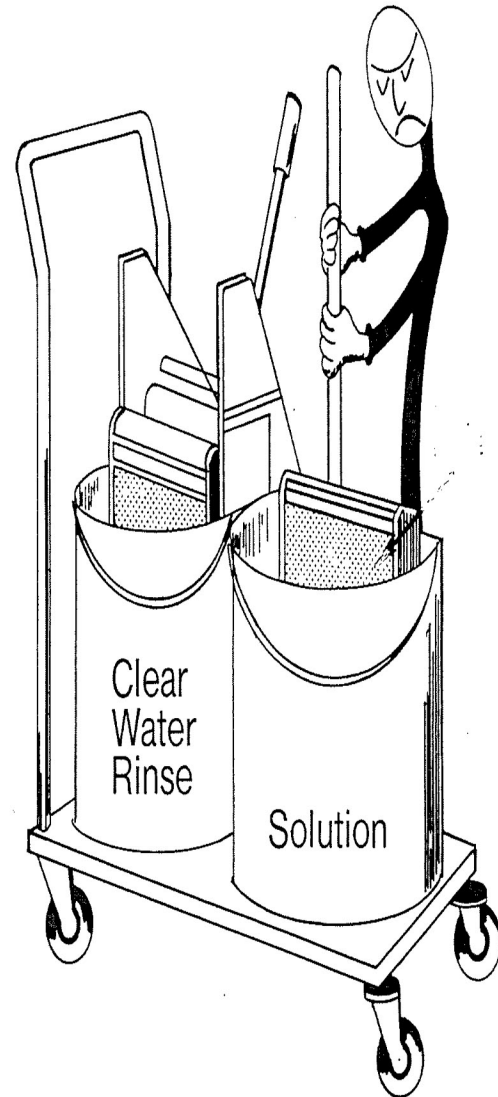
REMEMBER: The mop is never placed into the solution when returning from the floor. It is always taken to the clear water rinse bucket and agitated and wrung out before being placed in the solution.

Because the mop never comes from the dirty floor to the clean solution, the solution retains its potency until used up. This is extremely important where "triple cleaners" that clean, deodorize, and disinfect, are used.
